## **Notes**

The following vaccines are available at all clinics:

- DTaP, Tdap, Td, Polio, Hib, MMR, Hepatitis B, Chickenpox (varicella), Rotavirus, and Pneumococcal Conjugate are available at all clinic sites. Meningococcal is available for children 11-18 years of age. HPV (cervical cancer) vaccine is available for both girls and boys between the ages of 9-18 years. Must bring written immunization record to be eligible for vaccination.
- TB skin testing is available at the Tuesday clinics. Clients must return to the Public Health offices in 48-72 hours to have the skin test read.
- Spanish interpreters are available at all clinics.
- There is a small administration fee, no charge for MA/BadgerCare recipients. No one is denied vaccine for failure to pay.
- Children under age 18 must have a parent or legal guardian present or have written permission to be vaccinated.
- No appointment is necessary.
