

**Attention Walworth County Public Health Immunization
Clinics Customers:**

As of October 1, 2012, the Walworth County Public Health Department can no longer supply vaccine for anyone (children or adults) that has private insurance that covers vaccine, even if there is a deductible or co-pay. This comes from the CDC which provides funding for the vaccines they use.

If your private insurance covers vaccines, please see your doctor for immunizations.

The clinics will continue to provide vaccines for children and certain vaccines for adults who do not have health insurance or have Medicaid (Forward card) or Badger Care, and those who are Native American or Alaskan Native.

For the fall of 2012, flu vaccine for children will be available for \$5. Flu vaccine for adults will be available for \$30.00. Flu vaccine will be available in early September.
